Attendees:

Discussed best practices documents that have been created by the committee and the procedure for publishing them

- Needs to be covered under our policies and procedures and it should not go to the board
 - Need to create a policy and procedures committee

Issues

- EDI is not working well today frustrating and small companies are not using it
- How can we scale it? Shift or pivot?
 - What worked well 40 years ago, might not be the best answer today
- Identify what the 5 or 10 most important parts of the document are
- Any to Any
 - o End points can be different, but standard data in the middle
 - Light weight process rules for specific industries
- Use of attachments
 - Construction world
 - Medical attachments
- Education
 - People in the VA have no clue what EDI is
 - What's relevant to them and their job/function/process
 - Need end use examples
 - People don't use standards they complete tasks
 - Use a solution to take care of their needs
 - Is Network not providing value?
 - Why?
 - Antiquated software system
 - o Newer is better?
 - Not always. Explain the old way
 - Younger people think older is less secure and less capable
 - Companies move away from VANs when they no longer see VAN solving their issues
- Bridge
 - Data for business process
 - Web based API across industries
- Interoperability of service providers
 - Connect to connect, no matter the system
 - Phone number, email address
 - What is the ecommerce equivalent?
 - o Peppol
 - Distributed catalog of every receiver on the network
 - Invoice standard now in many countries based on UBL format
 - AS4 mandatory starting Feb 1st

- Back to attachments discussed a specific issue around an RMA
 - o Assembled component had a piece rejected that was a part of
 - Constant problem tracking and getting/sending documents
 - Done with attachments and spreadsheets
 - The world revolves around me manufacturers
 - Need is there to standardize the data

Policy and Procedures

- Need to create a sub-committee
 - o Suggested some members who would be good fit for the sub-committee
 - Need to determine how we will operate and how it will be governed
 - Try to have a checklist of tasks ahead by next virtual meeting
- Membership
 - No longer free
 - Need to have one of the X12 types of memberships to vote
 - Do get Glass with basic membership
 - Based on membership
 - Will we liaison with other groups and organizations?

Other

- Need to attract larger organizations to be represented at B2X
 - Amazon, Target
- Software vendors tend to bypass EDI correct this?
- Higher level of interest, higher level of participation
 - o 60-100 people goal
 - o Run Return to a tradeshow format at X12 meetings?
- Formerly pulled back by the old process of X12, not we can react quicker and become the solution for the problem
