1. Monday, September 29

1.1. Administration. The Wednesday, 10/1 meeting will start at 11:30 EDT.

1.2. Active

1.2.1. RFI 2774: TGH Harmonization may be interested in the X12N recommendation, so Stacey Barber will take it back to them for review.

1.2.2. RFI 1547

1.2.2.1. The following question was submitted as an MR and cancelled by staff to be brought to the subcommittee instead: “We believe 999 can be used to reject EDI transactions based on external code validations (SNIP5 edits). X12 RFI#1547 response stated that we should use 277CA or 835 instead of 999 for EDI transaction rejects based on external code validations. Please review and provide base for the RFI#1547 response.”

1.2.2.2. The following response was unanimously approved to be delivered to the submitter: “Yes, you may use a 999 to report external code validations. The RFI #1547 response doesn't contradict that. Instead, that response addresses the situation where a valid external code didn't meet a trading partner's business requirement.”

2. Wednesday, October 1

2.1. Active. RFI 2774

2.1.1. X12N management has approved the response. TGH Harmonization was looking at a guidance for the PER segment on how to deal with URLs. The guidance is that if you send URLs don't include the delimiters you've chosen.

2.1.2. Motion to approve this final version of the response passed unanimously: “While there is nothing explicitly identifying the format of the URL, for a public facing URL to have any

value, it needs to be as clear and consistent with other URLs that are supported by the owner of the domain. Both examples work if the delimiters defined in the ISA are not used. Example 2 is compliant with this TR3, and is part of URL present in example 1, which is also compliant with this implementation guide, assuming the values shown in either example are not used as delimiters.”

- 2.1.3. The subcommittee suggested adding an agenda item for the next meeting to consider whether X12.61’s reference to IETF RFC 3986 should be updated.
