# 008050 IMPLEMENTATION GUIDES

- Following the last standing meeting X12 leadership, including the ASC and X12N officers, spent some time considering the importance of producing 008060 implementation guides early in 2025
- After much deliberation, we decided that X12 will defer publication of the 008050 implementation guides in favor of focusing on publishing the 008060 implementation guides in Q1 of 2025.



# 008050 IMPLEMENTATION GUIDES

- Publishing the 008060 guides as soon as possible is critical to our goal of delivering enhancements our members and other implementers need to support their changing business process as well as federal and state rule making processes



# MR PROCESS – THE PREQUEL

- Some of you may recall that our MR implemented plan had several stages
- We are preparing to implement the final piece of the process in Q1 2025
- Over the past few years X12, has received a lot of feedback indicating that materially impacted non-members need to weigh in on our maintenance requests earlier in the process

# MR PROCESS – THE PREQUEL

- Receiving important industry perspectives *after* our subcommittees develop solutions to maintenance requests often means that our subcommittee constituents must rework pieces, or all, of the solution(s) they developed
- Receiving industry feedback sooner results in better solutions for our implementers and makes better use of our volunteer's time

# MR PROCESS – THE PREQUEL

- There will be some new terminology related to this enhancement to X12's processes
- *Suggestion – each enhancement request starts as a Suggestion instead of as an MR*
  - *Input – feedback provided by members, non-members, and other materially impacted organization*

# MR PROCESS – THE PREQUEL

- More details will be provided over the next few months including:
- *Instructions on how members and non-members alike indicate an interest in being notified that X12 is soliciting input on one or more MRs*
  - *Instructions on how the interested organizations access the suggestions and provide written feedback*
  - *Information about the timeline for this feedback step*

# MR PROCESS – THE PREQUEL

- When public input period ends, suggestion becomes an MR and the input collected is shared with the subcommittee assigned maintenance responsibility
- When a subcommittee moves a proposed technical solution forward in the MR process, they will produce a summary describing how the input impacted their technical solutions

# MEMBER SURVEY

- X12 is preparing a member survey related to implementation and use of the 834 Benefit Enrollment and Maintenance and its associated implementation guides
- Watch for more information on this activity in the next few weeks
- We will also be seeking non-member feedback
  - *I'd like to hear your suggestions related to where we should post links to the survey to ensure as many non-member responses as possible*



# RECOMMENDATION SET 2

- After some discussion with federal regulators and other advisory organizations, we intend to officially withdraw the second set of X12's HIPAA related recommendations

  - ~ 9,780 *Glass and User Licensees*

# X12 HIPAA POC STATUS

## → Current challenge

- *Verifying the transactions work as expected and don't break something that worked in 005010*
- *Validating the expected business benefits are realized*
- *Identifying unexpected obstacles and potential solutions or mitigation options*
- *Estimating implementation/transition costs*

# X12 JSON POC STATUS

## → Current activities

- *Immediate focus is on Supply Chain transactions with the intent of expanding to other industries*
- *Participants include solution providers/vendors, VANs, related associations, and retailers*
- *The participants have met a handful of times over the past few months*
- *Working through a specification document similar to [xsd.x12.org](http://xsd.x12.org)*
- *Plans are to gain consensus on the approach before exploring API-specific use cases*

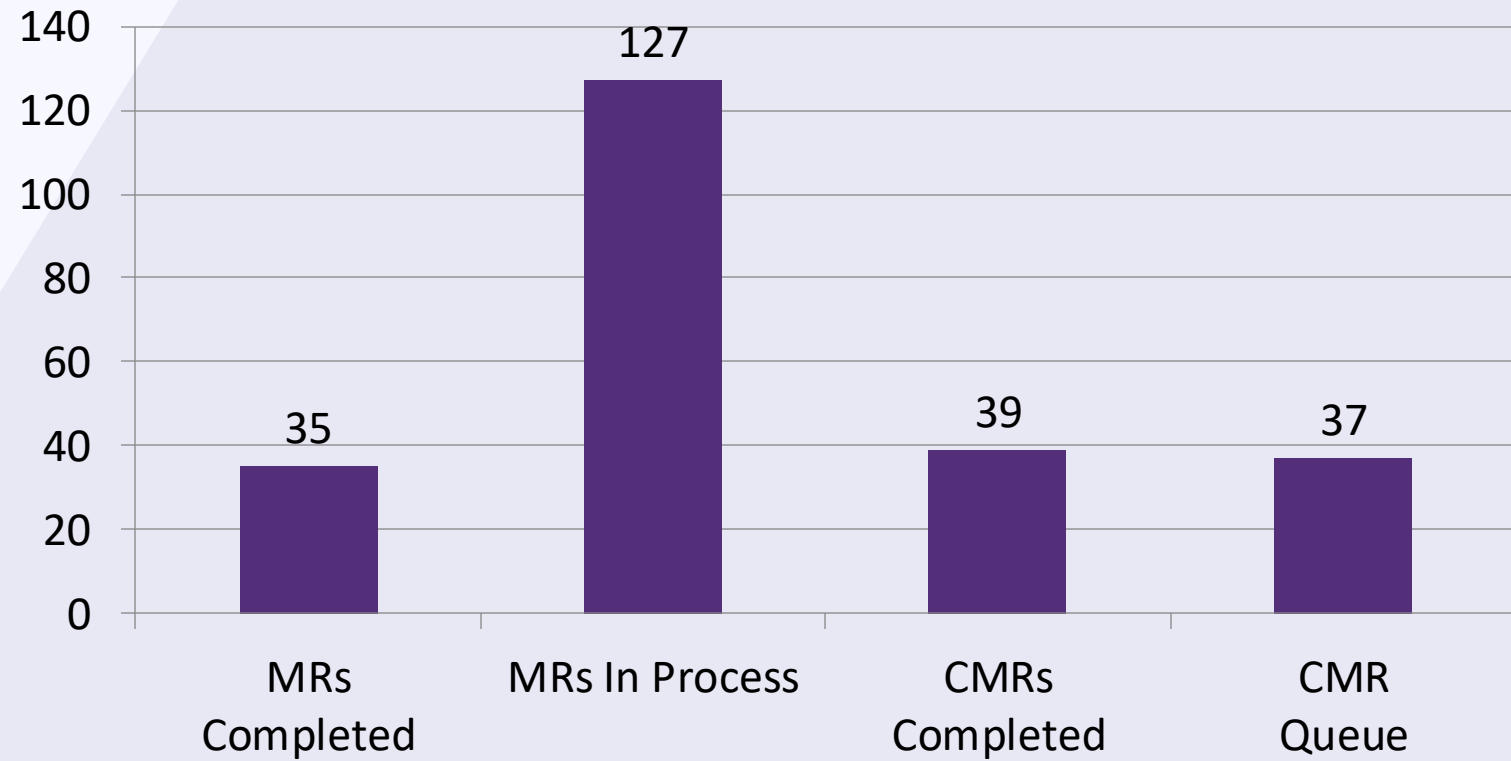
# CURRENT MR INVENTORY

- More than 32 MRs have been approved for 008060



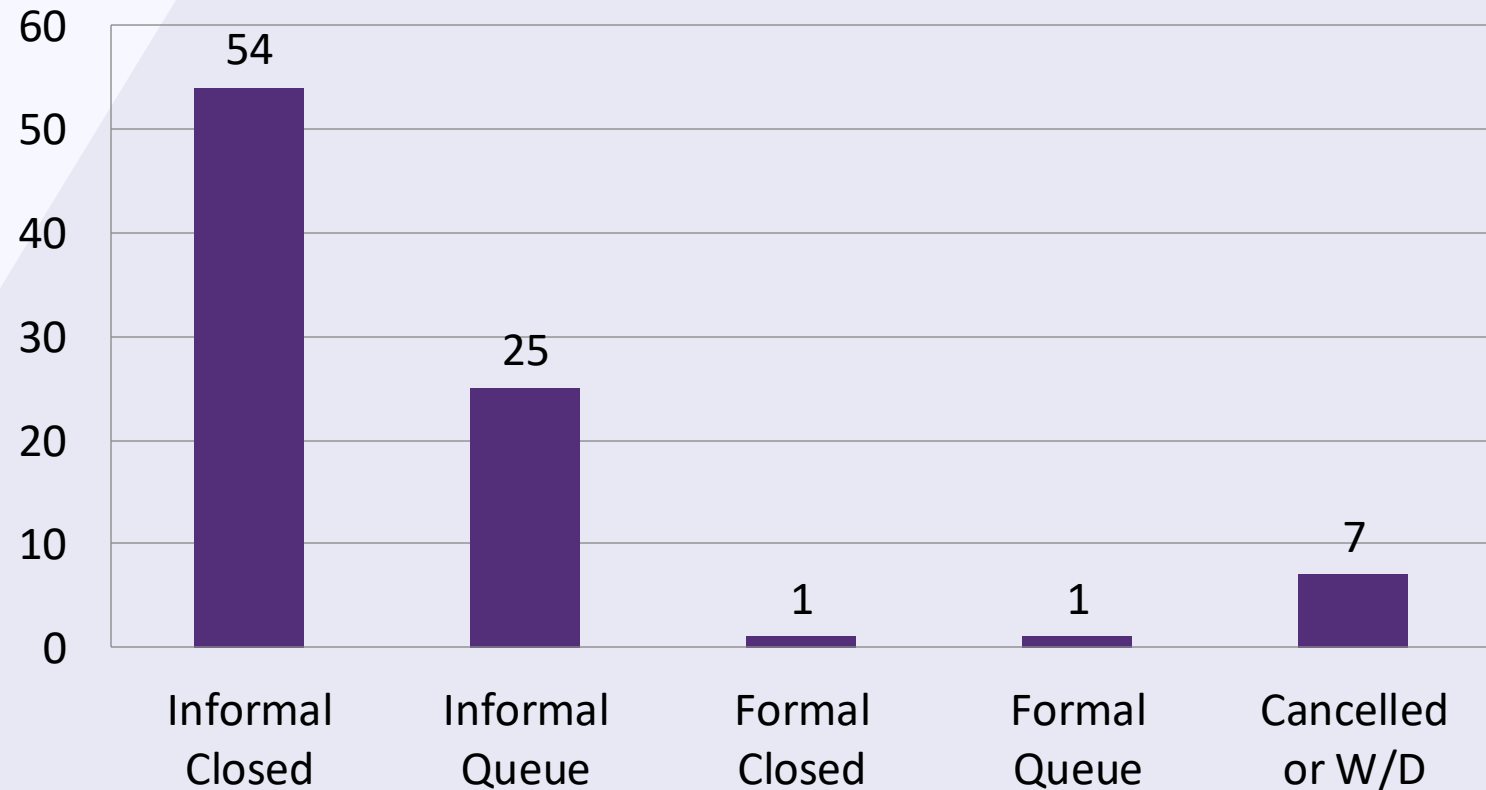

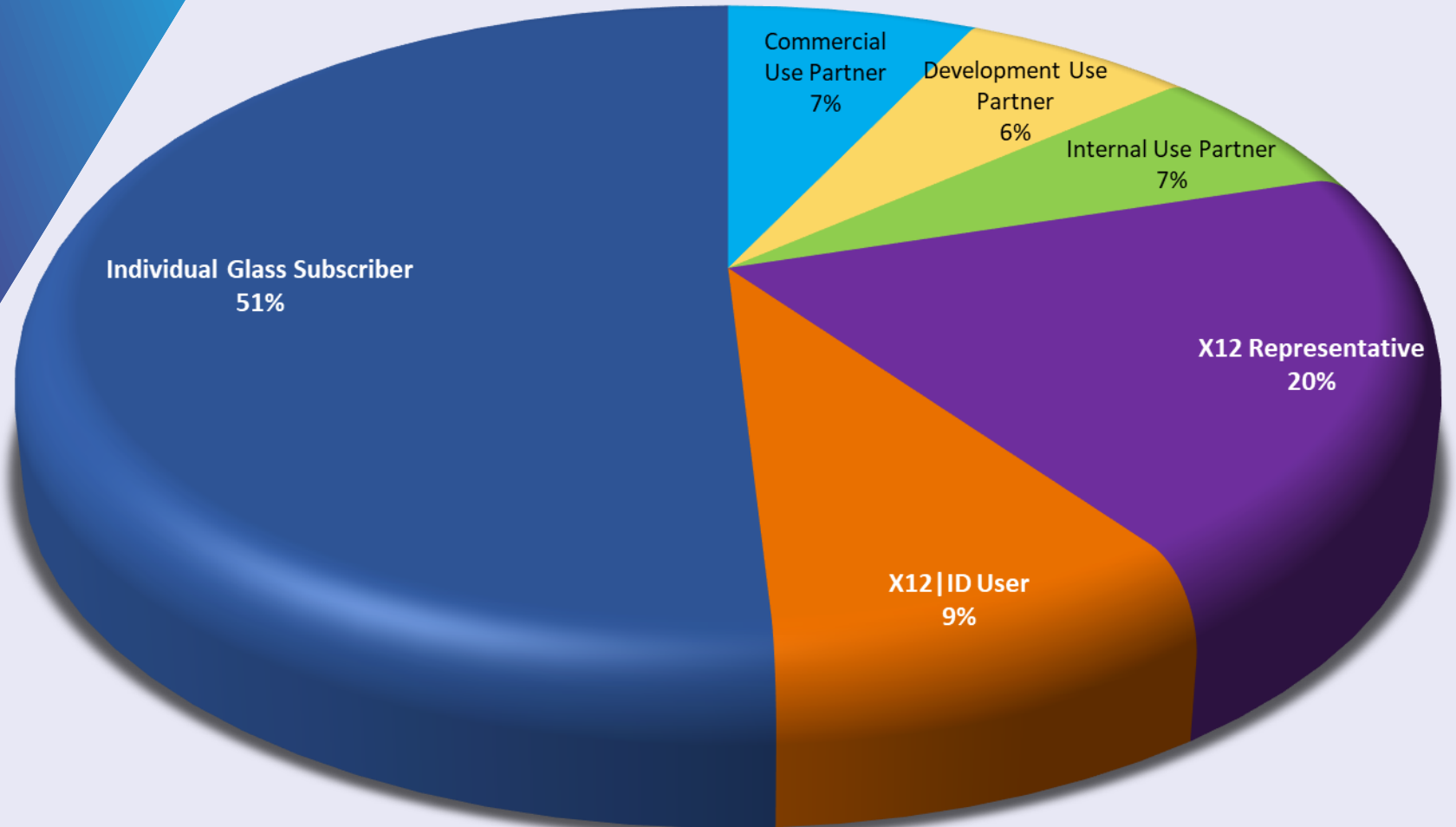

- *Version 8020 (CMS-0061); Proposed Rule Stage*
- *Regulatory number: [0938-AV43](#)*

“This proposed rule seeks to adopt the updated versions of the standards...this rule would propose to replace the X12 Technical Reports Type 3, Version 5010 with the X12 Technical Reports Type 3, Version 8020 for health care claims or equivalent encounter information transactions (Institutional, Professional, and Dental) and electronic remittance advice transactions.”
