1.4.1. X12 and Java Script Object Notation (JSON) discussion points:

1.4.1.1. We're not going to spend ten years talking about it. We need to decide whether to do something with JSON or not.

1.4.1.2. JSON is good for end-user delivery, dashboarding, syntax notes, light levels of data.

1.4.1.3. JSON schema wouldn't be useful for validation.

1.4.1.4. JSON is being used in most every industry.

1.4.1.5. Standard Development Organization use: HL7, NCPDP Telecommunication

1.4.1.6. Use case: Use X12 metadata to communicate with other B2B apps.

1.4.1.7. Would we use an isomorphic or an agile approach?

1.4.1.8. We could finish bridge.x12.org to add JSON representations and move it up a level to include messages.

1.4.2. Discussed the I17 code definitions and whether they should be more parallel. The Chair will discuss this with Gary Beatty who brought up the question.

1.4.3. Since X12.5 is not versioned, the subcommittee will need to research what version the ISX was first approved.
