1. Monday, January 22

1.1. Administration

1.1.1. An election for Chair was held with a quorum present. Steve Bass was re-elected to a two-year term.

1.1.2. The Wednesday, 1/24 meeting was cancelled.

1.2. RFI Database

1.2.1. Motion to approve the following response to [RFI 2669](#) “Clarification on Section B.1.1.3.1.4 String” passed unanimously: “The first scenario where there are three trailing spaces is correct and should not be rejected. The spaces are to satisfy a minimum length, they are not significant characters.”

1.3. MR 508 “Application Control Structure: Appendix B edit” was submitted by the Chair to include information about adding trailing spaces to meet minimum length requirements.

1.4. JSON discussion

1.4.1. Steering and the X12 Board of Directors have approved the subcommittee’s recommendations for JSON.

1.4.2. Pre-auth APIs could be a JSON use case. The industry is using isomorphic JSON.

1.4.3. The subcommittee’s recommendations included both isomorphic and non-isomorphic schemas.

1.4.4. JSON can handle the X12 syntax rules.

1.4.5. Next steps:

1.4.5.1. The X12 leadership group will provide some guidance.

1.4.5.2. Constituents should send the Chair any JSON use cases they know about.
